MASTER OF DIVINITY PROGRAM

BELLS, MICHAEL Michael is from Richmond Hill and received a B.Sc. from the University of Waterloo. He came to OTS to receive practical preparation for the pastoral ministry and to learn to do Greek and Hebrew Exegesis. He will be the interim pastor of Calvary Missionary Church in Owen Sound.

CHUNG, ANDREW Andrew comes from Seoul, Korea and received a B.Th. from Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Seoul. He served as Christian Education Director at the Sung-Min Presbyterian Church in Seoul. His purpose in coming to OTS was to be well qualified to serve the Lord in the future—especially in a western and evangelical way. He plans to receive more training in the future, working toward a Th.M. in N.T. in order to serve the Lord as a full-time missionary in an unreached field.
